# COMMUNITY UPDATE #7 – July 2025 PACIFIC BROOK CHRISTIAN SCHOOL




Figure: 3D Perspective of Stage 1 Development (Source: NBRS Architecture)

Since our last community update in May 2025, we are thrilled to share that the **Development Application** (**DA**) has been formally approved for our new school site at 72–74 Maitland Street, Muswellbrook. On 1 July 2025, our Project Team met with the Hunter and Central Coast Regional Planning Panel (HCC RPP) to present our final response to their previous requests for additional information. Following that meeting, the Panel has issued its approval for the proposed new 140-student school at Maitland Street.

This is a significant milestone for our school community. The DA approval paves the way for us to move confidently into the construction phase, bringing to life our vision for a purpose-built campus that will serve students from Kindergarten to Year 12.

This new facility represents a long-awaited opportunity to provide modern, fit-for-purpose learning spaces that reflect the high standard of care, character development, and educational excellence that families have come to expect from Pacific Brook Christian School.
