DA PROGRESS 72-74 MAITLAND STREET

We are pleased to provide an update on the development of our new school site at 72–74 Maitland Street, Muswellbrook.

Since our last community update in November 2024, the Development Application (DA) has progressed significantly. Following its public exhibition and initial Council assessment, the application was referred to the Hunter and Central Coast Regional Planning Panel (HCC RPP) for determination. This is a standard step for developments of this scale.

Over the past few months, our project team has been diligently addressing requests for additional information from the Panel. These have included refinements to the traffic and car park design, enhancements to our stormwater management system, and the preparation of a detailed Flood Emergency Response Plan to address the site's flood-related constraints.

We have appreciated the opportunity to present our response to the Panel and now anticipate a positive outcome in July 2025. This would allow us to move forward to the construction phase and bring to life the new Pacific Brook campus at Maitland Street.

This will ensure continuity of learning for our school community as we await development approval and prepare for the eventual transition.
